The Need for Single Stream Recycling

In 2005 we started taking all of the commercial waste that we collect in the Salt Lake Valley to a new type of transfer station, where between 15% - 20% of the materials taken in were being pulled for recycling. As time went on, the recycling materials dropped to less than 10%. This was a good first step in our efforts to get materials recycled in our area; but with the decline of material being recycled, we felt it was time to implement a new recycle program. This program is easy to use and a larger percentage of the materials are recycled.

Single Stream Recycling is designed to increase the amount of recycling, with less effort to our customers. With separate bins for trash and recycling, all recyclable items will go into one container, alleviating the need for sorting. This service is similar to the service that many cities are providing for their residents.

All your newspapers, junk mail, magazines, cardboard, plastics, aluminum, tin, and steel cans are able to go into the one container. All items are delivered to a recycle facility where they are sorted, processed and bundled. The material is then taken to the recycling mills to be re-manufactured into new products.

This single stream recycling program is available for residential communities and all types of businesses. We have dumpsters in a variety of sizes and curbside containers to accommodate your companies' needs. With the option to recycle, a business has the ability to reduce their trash service, since a good amount of items being thrown away can usually be recycled.

Our Single Stream service has been very successful and is currently being utilized in the Salt Lake Valley and Tooele County areas. Our goal is to eventually expand this service across the Wasatch Front.
