Ace Disposal is the proud owner of compressed natural gas trucks. We have four in our fleet currently with the plan to have many more in the future. We currently have two on order, giving us a total of four residential trucks and two commercial trucks. With these trucks we are able to help reduce the amount of toxins that are escaping into our environment every day by diesel fueled vehicles.

We currently are filling our trucks up at the nearest CNG fuel station, but in the near future we will be filling the trucks up at our own facility that is currently in progress of being built. Our new facility will have a CNG fuel station as well as a diesel fuel station for our other vehicles. The CNG trucks have a 210 gallon fuel tank, which takes 20-30 minutes with the 'fast fill' pump.

We are currently only using the CNG trucks in West Jordan, Midvale, South Salt Lake, West Valley, Sandy, and the Cottonwood area. We hope to expand the area once more fuel stations become available.

The power with a CNG engine versus a diesel engine is comparable, but the CNG engines are much quieter and cleaner. Our drivers are able to drive with the window down with out inhaling fumes from the exhaust.

On consumerenergycenter.org it states, "Natural gas vehicles show an average reduction in ozone-forming emissions of 80 percent compared to gasoline vehicles." With such a large decrease, it is hard not to imagine what a community could do to help out the environment if a

large percentage of residents used natural gas vehicles.

California has been using CNG vehicles for their trash for the last ten years. They've proven that it works and is more cost effective in the long run. Fuel for a CNG truck is \$1.00 per gallon and diesel currently is at \$2.26 per gallon.

We are very excited for the change that we are making, and we hope you are as well, and will join in on helping our community go green.



Curbside Bulk Pick Up

Warm weather is finally here, which means it is time to clean out the garage and get rid of all those large items that don't fit into your garbage container. With our new bulk pick up program we provide a way for you to dispose of all those large items at home or at the office with out you having to take them to the landfill yourself. All you need to do is put your bulk items out on the curb of your home or business and one of our vehicles will come and load it all up and take it away for you. We will go any where in the Salt Lake Valley.



ITEM SIZES AND GUIDELINES

- All loose items must be boxed or bagged
- If fridges have freon in them please call your power company. We will not take them. All fridges must have (No freon green sticker).

BOXES/BAGS must be no larger than a standard dishwasher

2 boxes = 1 item

2 (30-40 gallon bags) = 1 item

BRANCHES must be no longer than 4 feet, weigh no more than 70 lbs, and bundled (if not bundled cleanup charges will apply)

2 bundles = 1 item

OTHER ITEMS:

- Mattresses (all sizes)
- Couches, Chairs
- Dressers, Desks
- Carpet
- Bicycles
- Bathtubs, Toilets
- Dishwashers
- Stoves, Ranges
- Washers, Dryers
- Refrigerators (no freon)
- Water Heaters
- Microwaves
- Computers
- Swamp Coolers
- Lawn Mowers

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Dirt, rock, concrete, asphalt
- Hazardous Materials (paint, oils, etc.)
- Steel Poles (over 5 ft long)

Aluminum Recycling

Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to run a TV for three hours; or the equivalent of a half a gallon of gasoline.

Paper Recycling

Each ton (2000 pounds) of recycled paper can save 17 trees, 380 gallons of oil, three cubic yards of landfill space, 4000 kilowatts of energy, and 7000 gallons of water. This represents a 64% energy savings, a 58% water savings, and 60 pounds less of air pollution.

Plastic Recycling

Recycling plastic saves twice as much energy as burning it in an incinerator.



Single Stream Recycling
